

PARTNERSHIP OVERVIEW

- Personal degree mapping for each student and/or group of students as a cohort.
- Detailed transfer credit evaluation with a class by class/credit by credit equivalency determination.
- Cohort group planning for degree cohesiveness.
- Students receive a 33% reduction in standard tuition/fees:
 - Undergraduate tuition: \$600 per course
 - Graduate tuition: \$675 per course
 - Doctoral tuition: \$675 per course
- ✓ Up to 45 credits will transfer from your program + 70 credits through our accelerated degree options = 115 credits toward a 180 credit Bachelor of Arts degree at FIU.
- Person to person support for students: admissions process, class registration, Federal Financial Aid, and student advising.

TRANSFER CREDIT

- Up to 135 total quarter credits/90 semester credits may be accepted into any undergraduate degree program. The maximum allowable transfer credits from any one partnership program is 45 credits.
- Up to 24 quarter credits/18 semester credits may be accepted into any graduate degree program.



ACCELERATED DEGREE OPTIONS

In addition to the 45 credits earned from your program, FIU has provided an accelerated pathway to earn an additional 70 credits by taking **4 special courses***

MINISTRY PORTFOLIO

Students may earn up to **20 credits** for ministry/missions experience.



ACADEMIC PORTFOLIO


Students may earn up to **20 credits** for lifelong learning relating to academics. (Ex: health, computers, leadership, etc.)



OT/NT OVERVIEW

Students may earn up to **30 credits** for biblical knowledge in both the Old and New Testaments (15 credits for each class).

*Each of these 4 accelerated courses are the price of 1 five-credit course.



FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID

- Students have the opportunity to receive
 Federal Financial Aid.
- The **Federal Pell Grant** can cover the cost of tuition and fees at the partner rate.
- Students must be enrolled at FIU.
