



What is LCU Experience?

Lifestyle Christianity University is a ministry equipping school consisting of a student body who have undergone an interview process, paid tuition, and been accepted to attend LCU. We at Lifestyle Christianity want to give those who are not students the opportunity to visit, hear our speakers and experience an amazing encounter with Jesus at LCU without having to be full time students. To do this, we have developed a program where the public can visit and experience a day of LCU during the school year as a single-day, non-enrolled student. LCU Experience Student Attendance

LCU Experience days can be used on any school day (Monday - Thursday) throughout the school year (August - May) permitting that day is listed as available on our website. Please check our website to make sure LCU Experience Visitors are being admitted on the day you would like to attend. There is a maximum of 10 days available to visit per person, per school year.

*Please note that the weekly schedule is subject to change.

LCU Experience Refund Policy

An LCU Experience ticket ranges from \$25 - \$35 per person, per day. If you need a refund issued for your LCU Experience ticket, you must email admissions@lifestylechristianityu.com PRIOR to the day you planned to attend. The refund will be issued to the original payment method used for purchase. Refunds will not be issued for dissatisfaction with a session or not showing up for the day purchased.



LCU Experience Student Guidelines

- LCU Experience Students can attend class & participate in worship and will be required to sit in the section reserved for LCU Experience Students unless they are an immediate family member of a current LCU student and are attending as the student's guest.
- LCU Experience Students are allowed to attend classes in the main auditorium only including elective classes.
- LCU Experience Students cannot join or attend LCU Lifegroups, which happen on Thursdays from 11:30 - 1:00 pm, after the main session, as they are a relational time for full-time students and not open to the public.
- LCU Experience Students must be 18 years or older to attend. If you are a prospective student looking to visit LCU at the age of 17, then you must be accompanied by a parent.
- Parents who wish to visit, please be aware that children 17 years old and under, are not allowed. (We allow mothers to bring nursing infants up to 9 month old)
- The opportunity to receive ministry and prayer may arise during the day however, they are not guaranteed.
- Our speakers and pastors normally have a full schedule during the school day and are unable to have personal meetings with LCU Experience Students. For questions or prayer requests you can contact us through our website at www.lifestylechristianity.com
- The LCU Experience Program is designed for the participant to come and encounter Jesus, receive from our speakers, and enjoy the LCU experience. We ask that LCU Experience students refrain from ministering to LCU students or staff while on campus. This means the laying on of hands, giving prophetic words, and other types of ministry. LCU Experience days are designed specifically for the student to come and receive what God has for them within our school environment and culture. It is our desire that LCU Experience students come to LCU with an expectation of encountering Jesus, experiencing our LCU culture and enjoying a day of receiving from God.
