The LCU Student Housing Program is designed to support enrolled Lifestyle Christianity University (LCU) students as they transition to living in the Fort Worth, TX area. Once you've submitted your application, been accepted and have officially become an enrolled student, you'll gain full access to our program and resources to help make your move as smooth as possible.

HOW IT WORKS

2. **Schedule an Interview with our Student Housing Team**
3. **Receive Resources**
4. **Begin House Hunting & Meeting Potential Roommates**
5. **Take Steps to Prepare**

APPLICATION AND INTERVIEW PROCESS

Most housing options, including rental homes and roommate arrangements, will require an interview process. To increase your chances of securing popular housing options, we highly recommend preparing a **letter of recommendation** to help set you apart and demonstrate your responsibility and readiness.

FINANCIAL PREPARATION

Relocating can be costly, so it's essential to have savings set aside, especially if you plan to secure housing before finding employment. We suggest saving between **\$1,600 and \$3,200** to cover initial expenses.

RELOCATION COSTS

Be sure to research all potential costs based on where you are moving from. These may include:

- Flights or transportation fees
- Moving truck rentals (e.g., U-Haul)
- Rest stop expenses (food, gas, car maintenance, hotels)
- Home deposits and possible move-in fees

Important Note: The LCU Student Housing Program offers suggestions and resources to help guide your decisions. Ultimately, it is up to each LCU student to choose the living arrangement that best supports their journey and growth during this season. Remember, placements and roommate matches are **first-come, first-served**—start and complete your application today to secure the best options available!

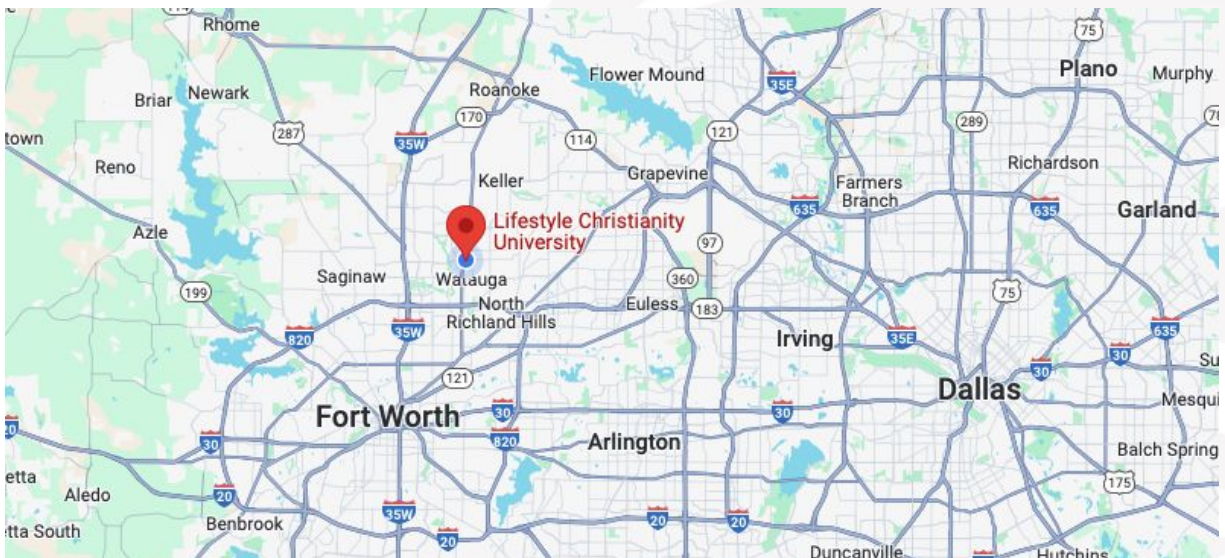
HOUSING COSTS TO CONSIDER

Housing prices will vary depending on your preferences and needs. Here is a general guide:

Renting a room in a host home (limited availability)	\$700–\$900 per month (May include utilities)
Renting a home	Starts at \$1,800 per month for an unfurnished home
Utilities	\$250–\$500 per month
Apartments	Range from \$1,800-\$2,700 for a 2 bedroom
